YEARS 11 & 12 EXAMINATIONS

DIRECTIONS:

1. Students should be ready to enter the exam room 15 minutes before the starting time. Please assemble outside the hall/designated room; for example for all morning exams, **please assemble by 8:45 a.m.** Sign the attendance sheet outside the room and you will be directed from there.
2. Students are not to enter the exam room until invited to do so.
3. Students are to ensure that all the necessary equipment has been obtained for the Exam. **NO borrowing will be permitted.** NO pencil cases or written material allowed.
4. The desk in which each student sits for the exams will have an exam paper with each student's name attached.
5. Students cheating will have their paper cancelled. However, the exam must be completed. Obviously final Assessment will be adversely affected.
6. No student will be permitted to leave the exam room before the appointed finishing time.
7. PERUSAL TIME - Each student will be permitted to make notes and read the exam paper for **ten** minutes prior to the start of the exam. All notes must be written on the sheet supplied ONLY. Before the exam, consideration should be given as to how best use this time. Check with teachers if uncertain.
8. Students needing to reschedule an examination due to significant and unavoidable circumstances need to make these arrangements with Mr McCulkin well in advance.
9. **If a student is ill and unable to attend**, a phone call must be made to Mr McCulkin, ideally prior to the commencement of the exam.
10. **Full College uniform** is required whenever present on campus.
11. Students will not be required for formal lessons during the exam week, instead, private study should take place at home. Students studying subjects without exams are to continue work on their respective subjects. Students at school must be either in exams or supervised study.
12. Mobile phones, iPods and MP3 players are not permitted.
13. Students with a first language other than English are permitted an extra 10 minutes per hour to complete the examination. **Electronic translators are not permitted.** Bilingual dictionaries are made available.
14. Graphic calculators are permitted but the memory must be cleared for all but Mathematics examinations.
